The 2018 Spring Aquatics Workshop is the third offering of the Yukon Pool School course. The program integrates current Pool Operator materials and training and includes a northern supplement that was created specifically for Yukon rural pool operators. The course is delivered by aquatics guru Sean Healy of the Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation and upon completion, will result in a BCRPA Pool Operators 1 certificate. Thanks to the generosity of the Yukon Government Sport and Recreation Branch, this year's workshop and certifications are being offered free of charge.
